

Fingerprinting & Background Check Information

Applicants for licensure must submit fingerprints to one of the vendors listed below for processing by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI) for the purpose of conducting a state and national fingerprint-based criminal history record check using CBI and FBI records.

The Division of Professions and Occupations (DPO) must receive the results of both background checks prior to issuing a license.

The Colorado Applicant Background Services (CABS) program requires electronic fingerprint transmission through two approved vendors, <u>IdentoGO Fingerprint Services</u> and <u>American Bioldentity - Colorado Fingerprinting</u>. Please use the following information to enroll and schedule an appointment (required) with either vendor.
